## वीज उपकेंद्रात बिघाड; बाजारपेठ दोन तास अंधारात

महावितरण कंपनीच्या शालिमार्ग सब स्टेशनमध्ये तांत्रिक बिघाड झाल्यामुळे व्यापारी बाजारपेठ असलेल्या एमजी रोड, मेनरोड, रिवार पेठ परिसरात विद्युत पुरवठा सुमारे दोन तास ठप्प असल्याने व्यापारी वर्ग त्रस्त झाले होते. शहराची मध्यवर्ती बाजारपेठ असलेल्या

मेनरोड, राजे बहादूर परिसर, एमजी रोड, रिवार पेठ, अशोक स्तंभ या परिसरामध्ये सुमारे दीड ते दोन तास वीजपुरवठा बंद झाला होता. त्यामुळे व्यापारी वर्ग त्रस्त झाले होते. आधीच उकाड्याने हैराण झालेल्यांना नेमण्या धंद्याच्या वेळेतच वीजपुरवठा नसल्याने बाजारपेठामध्ये नाराजी व्यक्त होत होती. त्याचवेळी वीज वितरणचे कर्मचारी विद्युत पुरवठा लाईनवर शाधण्यामध्ये व्यस्त होते. मात्र प्रत्यक्ष

सबस्टेशनमध्ये फॉल्ट आढळल्यानंतर त्याची दुरुस्तीचे काम गतिमान करण्यात आले आहे. त्याला वेळ लागणार असल्याने महावितरण कंपनीची अतिरिक्त कार्यकारी अभियंता नितीन धुमरे यांच्यासह सुमारे १५ कर्मचाऱ्यांनी सलग प्रयत्न करत शहराच्या या सबस्टेशनवरील विद्युत भार हा इतर सबस्टेशनमध्ये वळवून सुमारे दीड ते दोन तासांच्या अथक परिश्रमानंतर विद्युत पुरवठा सुळीत करण्यात यश मिळाल्याचे सांगितले.

IND vs AUS WTC

World reacts to Australia’s WTC triumph

LONDON: Legends of the game and former cricketers from India, Australia and across the world have congratulated the new ICC World Test Champions.

Australia’s 209-run win at The Oval saw them crowned WTC Champions as they handed India their second defeat in two WTC Finals.

Speaking on air at the moment of Australia’s triumph, former skipper Ricky Ponting summed up the mood.

“Look at what it means to this group of players. Two long and hard years of work, competing and winning Test matches all around the world has gone into this,” he said.

“Disappointment for India but they’ve been completely outplayed at The Oval by a very good Australian cricket team,” Ponting said.

And Ponting’s compatriot Matthew Hayden was similarly effusive in his praise for Australia’s triumphant players while discussing how India have once again struggled to deliver in a WTC Final.

“Outplayed by New Zealand in the last cycle and now Australia,” he said.

“This is now the ninth time that Australia has taken an ICC Championship of some sort. It really is impressive stuff from a country of 26 million

people,” Hayden said.

“A bold community of athletes and sporting heroes who combined on this world stage against a country of 1.4 billion. It’s impressive stuff,” he added.

Ponting and Hayden weren’t the only big names to react, with a number of stars of Indian cricket taking to social media to congratulate Australia.

And another huge name in Indian cricket had thoughts on where the Indian squad may have gone wrong.

Sachin Tendulkar said, “Congratulations to Team Australia on winning the #WTCFinal. @stevesmith49 and @travishead34 set a solid foundation on Day one itself to tilt the game in their favour. India had to bat big in the first innings to stay in the game, but they couldn’t. There were some good moments for Team India, but I fail to understand the exclusion of @ashwinravi99 in the playing XI, who is currently the number one Test bowler in the world. Like I had mentioned before the match, skillful spinners don’t always rely on turning tracks, they use drift in the air and bounce off the surface to disguise their variations. Not to forget, Australia had 5 left-handers out of their top 8 batters.”

India and Australia fined for slow over-rates

LONDON: India have been fined 100 per cent of their match fee and Australia 80 per cent of their match fee for maintaining slow over-rates in the ICC World Test Championship 2021-23 Final at The Oval.

Richie Richardson of the Emirates ICC Elite Panel of Match Referees imposed the sanctions after India were ruled to be five overs short of the target after time allowances were taken into consideration while Australia were found to be four overs short.

In accordance with Article 2.22 of the ICC Code of Conduct for Players and Player Support Personnel, which relates to minimum over-rate offences, players are fined 20 per cent of their match fee for every over

their side fails to bowl in the allotted time.

Captains Rohit Sharma and Pat Cummins pled guilty and accepted the proposed sanctions, so there was no need for formal hearings.

Meanwhile, India batter Shubman Gill has been fined 15 per cent of his match fee for breaching Level 1 of the ICC Code of Conduct.

Gill was found to have breached Article 2.7 of the ICC Code of Conduct for Players and Player Support Personnel, which relates to “public criticism of, or inappropriate comment in relation to an incident occurring in an international match.”

In addition to this, one demerit point has been added to

Gill’s disciplinary record, for whom it was the first offence in a 24-month period.

The incident occurred after the fourth day’s play when Gill criticised the umpiring decision for his dismissal in the second innings of the match on social media. Gill too accepted the sanction, so there was no need for a formal hearing.

On-field umpires Richard Illingworth and Chris Gaffaney, third umpire Richard Kettleborough and fourth umpire Kumar Dharmasena leveled the charges.

Level 1 breaches carry a minimum penalty of an official reprimand, a maximum penalty of 50 per cent of a player’s match fee, and one or two demerit points.

ICC world titles is like picking favourite kid: Cummins

LONDON: Pat Cummins and Test captaincy is a combination that goes hand in glove. And Australia’s triumphant skipper was in fine form when he took time out from the celebrations to speak to the world’s media in the bowels of The Oval’s Bedser Stand following his team’s ICC World Test Championship victory.

“I think the great thing about this final is we feel like we’ve played awesome cricket for the last two years and being there at the end holding the trophy feels really well deserved,” Australia’s charismatic captain said.

“Obviously the win is special, but to make it to the final you’ve got to win everywhere in the world. I think this cycle was 20 Test matches...and the boys were fantastic the whole way through. We adapted well and that’s what makes it so satisfying,” he said.

Cummins has now won an ICC title in all three formats of the international game. But choosing which is most special is not something that the 30-year-old wants to do.

“They all feel a little bit different – we were just talking about that,” Cummins said.

“No doubt Test matches for us are our favourite format; it’s the biggest challenge I think in every way. This competition, pitting us up against everyone in the world, it’s got to be right up there,” he said.

“I don’t know, it’s probably like trying to pick your favourite kid, but it’s satisfying,” Cummins said.

A victory like this deserves to be celebrated, and Australia wrapped up the win so early on day five that they opened up plenty of time to savour the victory before attention switches to another big series on the horizon, the ICC reported.

French Open final

Djokovic wins record 23rd men’s grand slam title

BELGRADE: Serbian tennis star Novak Djokovic has won a record 23rd men’s Grand Slam title, breaking a tie with Spain’s Rafael Nadal, after he beat Casper Ruud of Norway in the French Open final on Sunday.

The 36-year-old Serbian player secured his third French Open title, with a 7-6 (7-1), 6-3, 7-5 victory in a game lasting 3 hours and 13 minutes.

Nadal congratulated Djokovic on Twitter, saying that “23 is a number that just a few years back was impossible to think about.” The Spanish player pulled out of the French Open because of a hip injury.

Djokovic has under his belt three French Open titles, ten Australian Open titles, seven Wimbledon titles and three US Open titles.

In women’s tennis, Australia’s Margaret Court boasts the record



number of Grand Slam victories, 24, 13 of which she claimed before the Open era, which began in 1968. Djokovic is now tied with Serena Williams, who in women’s tennis has managed to rack up 23 Grand Slam titles.

Uruguay lifts U-20 WC trophy

LAPLATA, ARGENTINA: Forward Luciano Rodriguez scored late as Uruguay secured their first Under-20 World Cup title with a 1-0 victory over Italy on Sunday.

Rodriguez struck with a header as the 19-year-old ended a run of four consecutive European tournament triumphs for Uruguay.

“This is a feeling of champions of the world. What can I say?” said Rodriguez, who plays his club football for Liverpool Montevideo.

“It’s a feeling of ecstasy. We were the better team and deserved to win. This was such a close group. Every player gave their all in each training session and each match, and that was a telling factor in the end.”

More than 40,000 spectators watched the final at the Diego Maradona stadium in La Plata, around 50km southeast of Argentine capital Buenos Aires.



Tector & Puttawong clinch ICC Player of Month awards

DUBAI: The International Cricket Council (ICC) on Monday announced the winners of the ICC Player of the Month awards for May 2023.

In-form batter Harry Tector becomes the first Irish player to win the ICC Men’s Player of the Month award, while teenage sensation Thipatcha Putthawong seals consecutive Women’s Player of the Month awards for Thailand, emulating her skipper Naruemon Chaivai’s win back in April.

Both players were selected as the standout performers following a vote conducted among a specialist panel comprising ICC Hall of Famers, former international players, and media representatives, and global cricket fans registered at [icc-cricket.com](http://icc-cricket.com), who had been voting since the nominees were announced last week.
