

Defence production rises by 16.7%

NEW DELHI: The annual defence production has hit a record high of around Rs 1.27 lakh crore in Financial Year 2023-24, which is a rise of 16.7% over the last year, the Defence Ministry said.

As per the data received from all Defence Public Sector undertakings (DPSUs), other PSUs manufacturing defence items and private companies, the value of defence production in the country has gone up to a record high figure i.e., Rs 1,26,887 crore, reflecting a growth of 16.7% over the defence production of the previous financial year. The value of defence production in FY 2022-23 was Rs 1,08,684 crore, the statement said.

Acknowledging the

achievement through a post on X, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh said, "The 'Make in India' programme is crossing new milestones, year after year, under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi." "Many congratulations to our industry including DPSUs, other PSUs manufacturing defence items and the Private industry. The Government is committed to create more conducive regime for developing India as leading Global Defence Manufacturing Hub," Singh said.

Of the total value of production (VoP) in 2023-24, about 79.2% has been contributed by DPSUs and other PSUs and 20.8% by the private sector. The data shows that in terms of absolute value, both DPSUs and

PSUs and private sector have recorded a steady growth in defence production. The feat has been achieved due to the policy reforms, initiatives and ease of doing business brought in by the Government in the last 10 years with focus on attaining self-reliance. The indigenisation efforts have been pursued aggressively on a sustained basis, that resulted in the highest ever VoP. Moreover, the spiraling defence exports have contributed tremendously to the overall growth in the indigenous defence production.

It may be recalled that defence exports touched a record-high of Rs 21,083 crore in FY 2023-24, reflecting a growth of 32.5% over the last fiscal when the figure was Rs 15,920 crore.

HATHRAS STAMPEDE

Rahul meets families of victims

HATHRAS: Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha and former Congress



President Rahul Gandhi on Friday arrived at Uttar Pradesh's Hathras and met the families of the stampede victims. He said that the party is with them in this hour of grief.

Rahul also demanded the state government to find out the reason behind the unfortunate incident and

immediate disbursement of appropriate ex-gratia to the families of each deceased.

Later talking to the media, Gandhi said, "This is a very sad incident. Several people have lost their lives. I don't want to give it a political colour but there have been lapses from the administration side. We need to find out". "The most important thing now is that appropriate compensation should be given, as they come from very poor families and it is a difficult time for them. I also request the Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh to see the condition of the people and give them adequate compensation," the Senior Congress leader said.

Rajnath misled House on Agniveers: Cong

NEW DELHI: The Congress on Thursday accused Defence Minister Rajnath Singh of telling half-truths in Lok Sabha on the plight of Agniveers and demanded a white paper on the Agnipath Scheme.

Addressing a press conference at the party headquarters, Chairman of the Ex-Servicemen Department, Col (Retd) Rohit Chaudhary and Wing Commander (Retd) Anuma Acharya demanded that the government should bring a white paper to present details of the scheme.

The party reiterated its stand to scrap the Agnipath scheme since it was against the security inter-

ests of the country.

The Congress alleged the scheme was creating differences and discrimination between soldiers within the defence services.

Referring to Rajnath Singh's intervention in Parliament claiming that families of those Agniveers who die in the line of duty are paid Rs one crore, Col Chaudhary said the Minister did not give the complete picture.

He said if an Agniveer gets killed in the line of duty he gets Rs 48 lakhs from the insurance, Rs 44 lakhs as ex-gratia and Rs eight lakh for battle casualty.

Col Rohit disclosed that a regular soldier gets about

Rs 2.43 crores equalized up to 15 years of service in the rank of Sepoy and about Rs 3.25 crores for Havaldars whose service tenure is up to 24 years.

He said Agniveers are not granted martyrdom status and benefits associated with it.

Speaking on the occasion, Wing Commander (Retd) Anuma Acharya condemned the misuse of the social media handles of the defence services for spreading disinformation by the government.

Referring to Defence Minister's claim that the Agnipath scheme was introduced after consultations with about 158 organizations, she said, he must come out with details.

LIQUOR SCAM

Delhi HC issues notice to CBI

NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court on Friday issued notice to the CBI on the bail plea filed by Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, who is in CBI custody in connection with the alleged liquor policy scam. Justice Neena Bansal Krishan, after hearing the bail plea, sought a response from the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and listed the matter for hearing on July 17. When Kejriwal's plea challenging his arrest is also listed.

Senior Advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, appearing on behalf of the Delhi Chief Minister, said, "This is not a case where even the remotest allegation of triple test is being touched. Four people have got bail in this case. On a normal bail test, which test keeps him in jail? He has been arrested after two years."

The triple test or the tripod test for deciding bail application takes into account whether the accused is a flight risk, whether there is apprehension of the accused tampering with the evidence, and whether there is apprehension of accused influencing witnesses.

Change crop insurance policy: MPCC chief

MUMBAI: Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) president, Nana Patole, on Thursday demanded that the Mahayuti government should amend the crop insurance policy for benefit of farmers.

Talking to media persons, he took a swipe at the BJP-led Shinde government saying that the drought-like condition is serious in many parts of the state including Marathwada, farmers are in distress, they are not getting any help, on the other hand, crop insurance companies are filling their pockets by allegedly looting farmers.

The state government is with the crop insurance companies, he alleged.

The MPCC chief said that farmers are not getting compensation from crop insurance companies even

as they are facing drought-like condition.

Unless their name is not registered with the Revenue department's website, crop insurance is not available to them, he said and claimed that their website is shut.

He further said that farmers' suicides have not stopped in Maharashtra, as four farmers are committing suicide every day, even during the Monsoon session.

"If farmers survive, the country will survive," he noted and accused the Shinde government of being anti-farmer.

"This government does not want farmers to benefit," he charged.

Talking about scholarship to backward class children, Patole claimed that OBC children have not been given scholarship for last five years.

Inspect bridges over 50 years old, says Yogi

LUCKNOW: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said that over the past seven years, the state has witnessed exceptional growth in its road network and since 2017, the highway has expanded from 7,002 km to 10,214 km and rural roads have increased from 1,87,517 km to 1,93,581 km.

While reviewing the updated status of various projects of the Public Works Department, emphasising the importance of ensuring timeliness and quality in construction works, the CM said, "Similarly, the network of major district roads and other district roads has also expanded. On average, 9 km of roads are being widened or strengthened every day in the state and about 11 km of new roads are being built in the villages every day."

He said, "Given the crucial role of connectivity in fostering development, this pace of road construction sets a new benchmark, prompting further efforts to enhance it."

Yogi said that all bridges in the state that have reached the age of 50 years must undergo a thorough inspection. "This inspection should meticulously examine the condition of their superstructure, pier and blockage in the waterway of the bridges, scour holes on the side of the pier and the abutment slope and boulders of the bridge. If any bridge is found to be unsafe during inspection, it should be promptly closed to traffic. Local district administrations must be informed accordingly," he said.

He said that before the upcoming Kanwar Yatra, the roads connected to it in the districts should be made 100 percent pothole-free. "This task should be accomplished by July 15. Measures should be taken to ensure adequate drainage at locations prone to water logging," he said.

The CM said that the commitment to provide two-lane road connectivity to block headquarters must be met within the designated time frame.

CHHATRAPATI SAMBHAJINAGAR: Panicked 430 farmers committed suicide by different means across Marathwada region in the past six months. They had taken extreme step, fed up with debt, barrenness and depression. Divisional Commissioner sources said on Friday that on an average three farmers commit suicides per day.
