

Australia all-rounder ready to go for third Test

INDORE: Australia’s Cameron Green has declared himself “100% ready” for the third Border-Gavaskar Trophy Test due to be played in Indore.

Green had broken a finger while batting during the Boxing Day Test against South Africa last year. The Western Australia player was very close to playing the second Test in Delhi but eventually decided against it.

“I was so, so close last game, but I think probably having an extra week has helped a lot, I am 100% ready to go,” Green went on to explain why he missed the Delhi Test. “It’s just a few instances in the nets where I’d go for a sweep and it just jarred the end of my bat.” “We probably just thought that we’d sacrifice a game and with obviously the year ahead that we’ve got, it’s probably the right

call,” he said.

Green’s return to the setup is a big relief for the Australia side, which is already battling injuries and departures. The likes of David Warner, Ashton Agar and Josh Hazlewood have already left, while skipper Pat Cummins is also in Australia to attend to a family emergency.

Cummins will miss the third Test in Indore, with Steve Smith taking over as the skipper.

In Green, Australia will relish an added pace bowling option. The all-rounder has 806 Test runs at an average of 35.04 and six half-centuries to his name. He has also picked 23 wickets at an average of 29.78, with one five-for.

The third game between India and Australia is all set to begin from March 1, with India leading the four-match series 2-0.

Shastri lauds evergreen James Anderson

DUBAI: India great Ravi Shastri is not surprised to see James Anderson become the No.1 ranked Test bowler in the world at the age of 40 and believes the evergreen England quick is easily among the best fast bowlers to have ever played. Shastri spoke in awe of Anderson when discussing the recent big change to the ICC Men’s Test Rankings on the latest episode of The ICC Review, as the England seamer climbed to the top of the tree for Test bowlers for the sixth time in his career.

The former India captain recalled the amount of work Anderson used to put in to ensure he was always at his best and said it is his ability to train at 100 percent that makes him stand out from the rest and is allowing him to prosper so late

in his international career.

“I used to watch him so closely when I was a coach on tours of England every time. And what I used to admire was his work ethic,” Shastri said.

“Even in Indian conditions, there were times he didn’t play in India. But he would go out to bowl at lunch or straight after the day’s play or before the day’s play,” he said. “I would say he would bowl 20 balls or 25 balls at the most.

But every ball, he would give it his all. And at times I would tell my fast bowlers, ‘Just watch that. Just watch the professionalism, the work ethic’, Shastri said.

“And it’s not a half-hearted delivery. Those 15-20 balls, whatever they had to bowl, would be as if he’s bowling in a game. He bowls six and

maybe takes a little break as if it’s someone else’s bowling. Then come back and do that. And then the action, the follow through and the rhythm, the running in, was just the same for all those 20 balls,” he said. “So these are real professionals, and a stickler for fitness. You can’t play at 40 and produce these kinds of results unless you are supremely fit. So, hats off. Well done, Jimmy. I would say. He’s a role model. He inspires so many. Leave alone batters playing at the age of 40, but for a fast bowler to play at 40, you just salute it,” Shastri said.

Anderson’s longevity has helped him amass a total of 682 Test wickets, with spin duo Muttiah Muralitharan (800) and Shane Warne (708) the only bowlers to have more Test scalps to their name.

BENGALURU: Simon Grayson’s Bengaluru FC added to their winning streak, sending FC Goa out of the running for a spot in the Indian Super League playoff with a 3-1 result at the Kanteerava Stadium on Thursday. Striker Sivasakthi Narayanan scored a brace while Spanish midfielder Pablo Perez added another off the bench to seal an eighth successive win for the Blues, a club record in the tournament.

The visitors came into the game looking for a win, one that would guarantee their spot in the playoffs.

The Blues, meanwhile, were after three points that would see them extend their winning streak to eight games. Earlier, Grayson made two changes to his side, as striker Roy Krishna and defender Parag Shrivastava returned in place of Sandesh Jhingjan and Javi Hernandez, both at risk of suspension.

The Blues made the perfect start as Roshan Singh’s corner was headed in by Sivasakthi in the sixth minute. The attacking threat continued as a free-kick,

delivered by Roshan again, was met by Sunil Chhetri, but the skipper’s effort was parried away by FC Goa ’keeper Dheeraj Singh.

The visitors had their first big chance when Redeem Tlang unleashed a shot from 25 yards which forced Bengaluru ’keeper Gurpreet Singh Sandhu into a sharp save, diving low to his left. The Gaurs eventually equalized when Spanish striker Iker Guarrotxena found himself in space in the box, and headed home a cross from Noah Sadaoui to register his 11th goal of the League season.

Bengaluru pushed forward, but came up against a stubborn Goa backline manned by Anwar Ali and Syrian Fares Arnaout, as both sides made their way back down the tunnel with the scores level. Into the second period, the Blues had a chance to get themselves back into the lead in the 54th minute as Roy Krishna’s attempt to control the ball off a long pass threatened to trickle into the net past Dheeraj, but it wasn’t to be as the ball went agonizingly wide for the Blues.
