

RS pays homage on 81st Anniversary of Quit India Movement

NEW DELHI: The Vice-President and Chairman, Rajya Sabha, Jagdeep Dhankhar paid homage to our freedom fighters on the 81st Anniversary of the historic ‘Quit India Movement’. In his statement in the Upper House, he called for reaffirming our commitment to uphold the sovereignty, integrity and rededicate ourselves for the service of Bharat.

Double turnover of Agriculture Corporation: Minister

MUMBAI: Agriculture Minister Dhananjay Munde on Tuesday directed to the concerned officials that they should make efforts to double the turnover of Maharashtra Agricultural Industry Development Corporation Limited (MAIDCL) by bringing innovation in fertilisers, pesticides, agricultural implements and processed goods.

He gave this direction during a review meeting of the MAIDCL held under the Department of Agriculture, Government of Maharashtra, at Mantralaya. The Corporation has 13 divisional offices and 10 manufacturing units, which include fertiliser factories, animal feed factories, MIL, agricultural engineering factories. When officials pointed out that production has been declining every year as the raw materials required for production in these factories are distributed in controlled quantities by the central government, Munde said that emphasis should be on introduction of products based on modern technology. Upper chief secretary of Agriculture Department Anup Kumar, Agriculture commissioner Sunil Chavan, MAIDC managing director Sunil Chavan, deputy general manager Suresh Sonwane and various office-bearers of the Corporation were present at the meeting.

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav has shown a vision of new India: Yogi

LUCKNOW: Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Wednesday said that ‘Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav’ has shown a vision of a new India where there is no discrimination against any citizen on the basis of caste, creed and religion.

While launching the ‘Meri Mati, Mera Desh’ campaign by unveiling a Shila Falkam Phalakam on the occasion of the 98th anniversary of the Kakori Rail Action, the CM paid tributes to the great revolutionaries, martyrs, brave jawans guarding India’s borders and soldiers who contributed towards improvement in internal security.

Urging the people to upload selfies taken at the Martyrs’ Memorials, he said, “The tricolour is the symbol of our pride. It should be raised at every residence.” Yogi asked the people to stand at their place from August 13 to 15 and worship the soil and bow down to the heroes.

He said that August 14, 1947 was the day of the tragedy of the partition of India and that another partition of

the country would not be allowed at any cost. The CM said, “Every citizen must take the resolution of ‘Ek Bharat, Shrestha Bharat’. Teachers should do teaching, students should study, social workers should uplift society and people engaged in administrative work should fulfil their responsibilities honestly. Those who are not discharging their civic duties are cheating the nation.”

He said that even though the present generation could not witness the celebration of independence, they are fortunate to participate in the celebration of India’s 75th year of independence. “We have become the fifth largest economy, replacing Britain which ruled us for 200 years. India is presiding over the G-20 and moving towards self-reliance. The nation is paving the way for the welfare of humanity in the world,” the CM said.

Yogi said that 98 years ago, it must have been a time of upheaval when people started realising that the days were over for foreign rule in

India and revolutionaries like Pandit Ram Prasad Bismil took forward their resistance movement.

The Chief Minister said, “The money that the revolutionaries got in the Kakori train action was Rs 4,679. The British government spent Rs 10 lakh rupees from the arrest of the revolutionaries till their hanging. If there is passion, determination and willpower to fight, then the biggest physical force can be brought down. This spirit had forced the despotic regime of that time to surrender.”

Remembering revolutionaries like Birsa Munda on International Tribal Day, he said that the day is remembered in the history of India for many historical events. “Tribal society had played an important role in the independence of India. India is proud of its heritage,” Yogi said.

Appealing to the people of the state to join the ‘Meri Mati, Mera Desh’ campaign, the CM said that every gram panchayat and municipal body will be associated with ‘Panch Pran’ through Shila Phalakam.

No confidence motion

BJP-led govt murdered voice of people: Rahul

NEW DELHI: Congress MP Rahul Gandhi on Wednesday took a dig at Prime Minister Narendra Modi in the Lok Sabha for not going to strife-torn Manipur. He accused the BJP-led government of murdering the voice of people in Manipur.

Gandhi, on the second day of discussion on the no-confidence motion in the lower house said, he went to Manipur and spoke to women and children regarding the violent incidents that happened there but the PM didn’t go, not even till day.

He alleged, “You (without taking

name) have divided Manipur into two and broken the state. India is the voice of our heart, the voice of the people. The Modi government has murdered the voice of people in Manipur.”

“The people of the country have pain, sorrow and difficulties. To hear this voice, we have to destroy our ego. Only then will we hear the voice of India,” said the Congress MP.

Union Minister of Women and Child Development, Smriti Zubin Irani opposed the motion and hit out at Congress saying

that Manipur is not divided, it is an integral part of India. It was, it is and it will be an integral part of India.

She mentioned that Parliamentary Affairs Minister Pralhad Joshi, Union Home minister Amit Shah and Defence minister Rajnath Singh repeatedly said that the government was ready to discuss on Manipur but Opposition ran away from debate.

Smriti Irani said, “I spoke to Manipur CM and requested him to take quick action against the accused and after they were arrested and a CBI probe is being done.”

BJP to organise Partition Vibhishika Day

HAMIRPUR (HP): Himachal Pradesh BJP State General Secretary Sikandar Kumar said on Tuesday the party would organise the Partition Vibhishika (Horror) Memorial Day program on August 14 all over the state.

In the program, the BJP would be observing August 14 every year as the commemoration day of Partition. Like every year, this year also it has been decided to observe Partition Vibhishika (Horror) Smriti Divas at divisional level across the country.

Kejriwal lauds Stalin

CHENNAI: Aam Aadmi Party Chief and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Wednesday expressed gratitude to his Tamil Nadu counterpart and DMK President M.K.Stalin for his party’s support in rejecting and voting against the GNCTD (Amendment) Bill, 2023.

In the Parliament on Monday, the AAP voted against the Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (Amendment) Bill, 2023, that gives the central government control over bureaucrats in the Delhi government when it was passed in the Rajya Sabha.

Hope that SC will give a just and fair verdict: Mufti

SRINAGAR: Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) President Mehbooba Mufti on Wednesday said the verdict on Article 370 would decide whether the decision of leadership of Jammu and Kashmir to disapprove the two nation theory and accede to a secular and democratic India was right in the first place. Mufti expressed satisfaction on the way lawyers are “laying bare the patent illegality and unconstitutionality” of the abrogation of Article 370 in the Supreme Court.

The Apex Court is hearing a bunch of petitions challenging the abrogation of Article 370. Mehbooba told reporters that she is relieved that the BJP-RSS dispensation will not be able to stifle

the voices and arguments against such an unlawful act in the Supreme Court.

She said that she and her party colleagues have been trying their best to give voice to the sentiments of the people of Jammu and Kashmir since the day the state was dismembered and its special status was snatched away. However, they have had to face the brunt of the brute establishment that has been trying to muzzle the voices of dissent, the PDP President said.

Mufti said that it is being openly described in the Supreme Court how the then Governor self-appointed himself as the constituent assembly and his advisors assumed the role of the council of ministers.

Thwart challenges from across the border: DG BSF to troops

JAMMU: Director General Border Security Force, Nitin Agrawal on Wednesday asked troops to thwart all the challenges from across the border.

The DG was on three-day visit to Jammu Frontier and on the last leg of his visit, he visited border areas of Akhnoor alongwith P V Rama Sastry, SDG (Western Command), D K Boora, IG Jammu Frontier and other officers.

The officers reviewed the border domination and security situation on IB. “Carry on excellent work in effective domination of border to thwart continuous challenges from across the border,” the DG exhorted troops. BSF Sector commander and Battalion commanders briefed DG BSF

on the ground and explained overall BSF deployment and domination of area under prevailing security scenario.

He was also informed about border management aspects of BSF Battalions deployed in the area wherein the local border population is assisted in terms of regular civic action programmes and border area medical camps.

DG BSF visited various Border Outposts and witnessed the operational preparedness of field formations.

During the visit, DG BSF interacted with troops and applauded their professional acumen in safe guarding the International Border in stringent conditions relentlessly.

Total aid from NATO, EU, partners to Ukraine exceeds \$160 bn

MOSCOW: The total amount of assistance from NATO, the European Union and their partners to Ukraine has exceeded \$160 billion since February 2022, Russian Defense Minister Sergei Shoigu said on Wednesday.

“Since ... February [2022], Ukraine has received hundreds of tanks, more than 4,000 armored combat vehicles and armored vehicles, more than 1,000 field artillery pieces, as well as dozens of modern Western-made multiple launch rocket systems and anti-aircraft missile systems. The total amount of assistance

from NATO, the European Union and their partners exceeded \$160 billion,” Shoigu said during a meeting of the board of the military department.

The US is raising stakes, seeking to supply Ukraine with weapons reaching targets at a longer range, the minister sais, adding that Washington committed a war crime by including cluster munitions prohibited by the international convention in the aid package to Ukraine. “NATO countries are currently actively working on the issue of transferring F-16 tactical fighters to Kiev,” the official added.

350 flights cancelled

TOKYO: About 350 flights operating between the prefectures of Miyazaki and Kagoshima on the Japanese island of Kyushu and other regions have been canceled due to the powerful Typhoon Khanun, Japanese media reported on Wednesday.

Currently, the pressure in the center of the cyclone is 970 hectopascals. The wind speed is 30 meters (98 feet) per second, with gusts of up to 40 meters.
